

New Boat Title & Reg

Print, fill out, & sign (**ALL Owners must sign**) a **Registration Form (Tilted)**. This form can be found on our website www.license.mn.com click **Forms** tab then under the **DNR Forms** section (toward bottom of page)

If there is a lien on the boat include lienholder name, address & date of loan

Print a copy of each new owner's Drivers License(s).

Fill out form carefully, nothing can be crossed out or changed. Write down your phone # & email address & verify your home address if different from what is on your drivers license.

Include this form as well as your MSO (if new) or "current out of state title" when you return this to our office. If you are comfortable with this option, include a signed blank check pay to order of "Brainerd License Office"

Write your DL# & Phone# on check.

If you purchased boat from a dealership & paid sales tax, please submit a copy of your receipt showing that sales tax has been paid.

For *Credit or Debit Card Payment* write **Card #, Exp date & cvv#** on your request. (you must use your card). A 2.49% handling is also charged by the bank. We will destroy your card information once completed. Money orders are also acceptable.

Quotes are difficult as fees vary depending on transaction types & how many fees apply.
